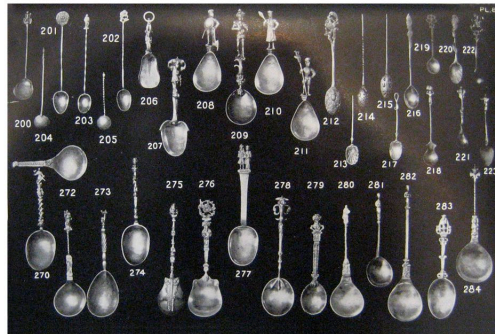
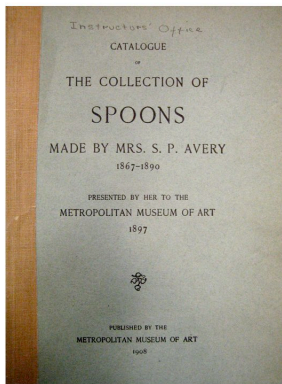

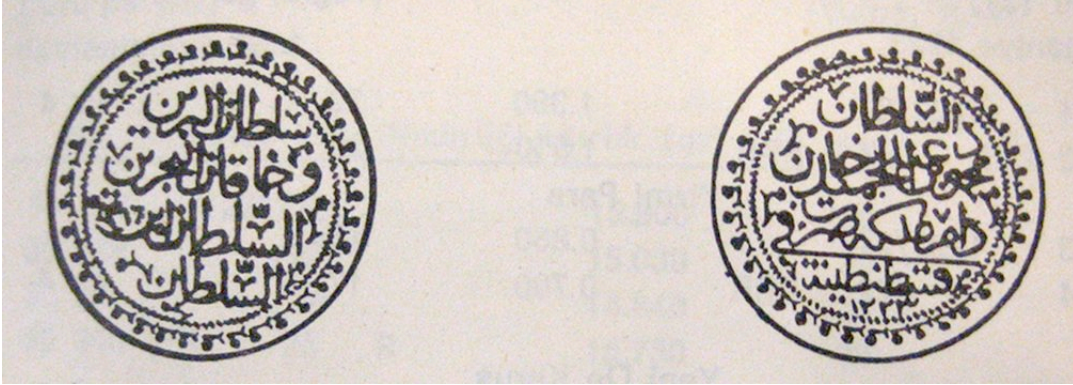

2) Title page and image of Plate 8 with the Ottoman coin spoon numbered 205 in the catalogue on the Avery spoon collection. New York: 1908.



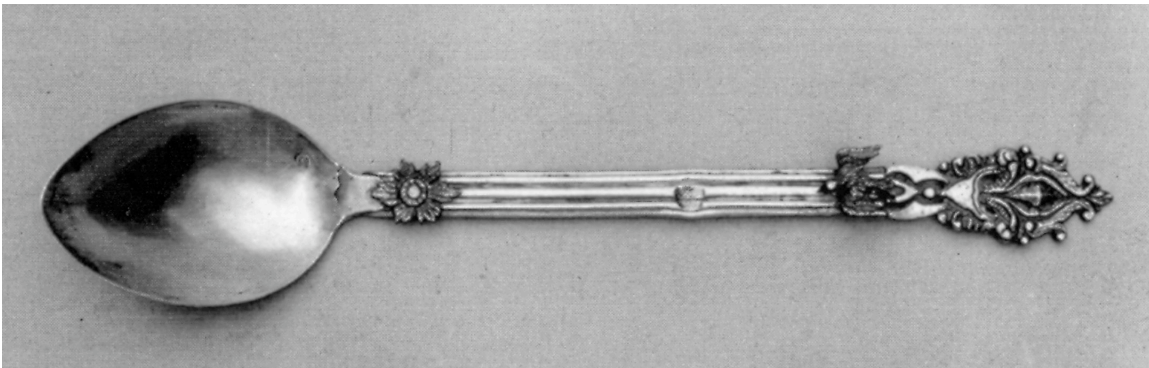

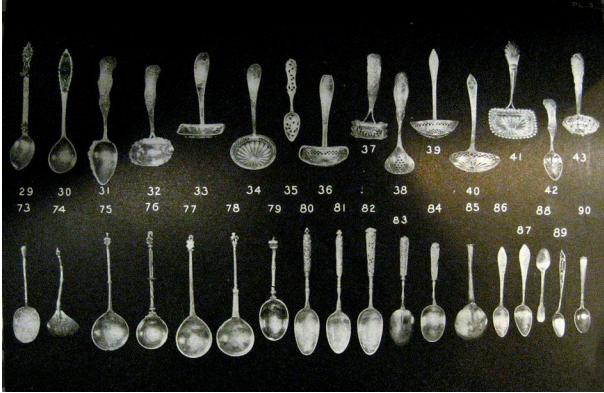
